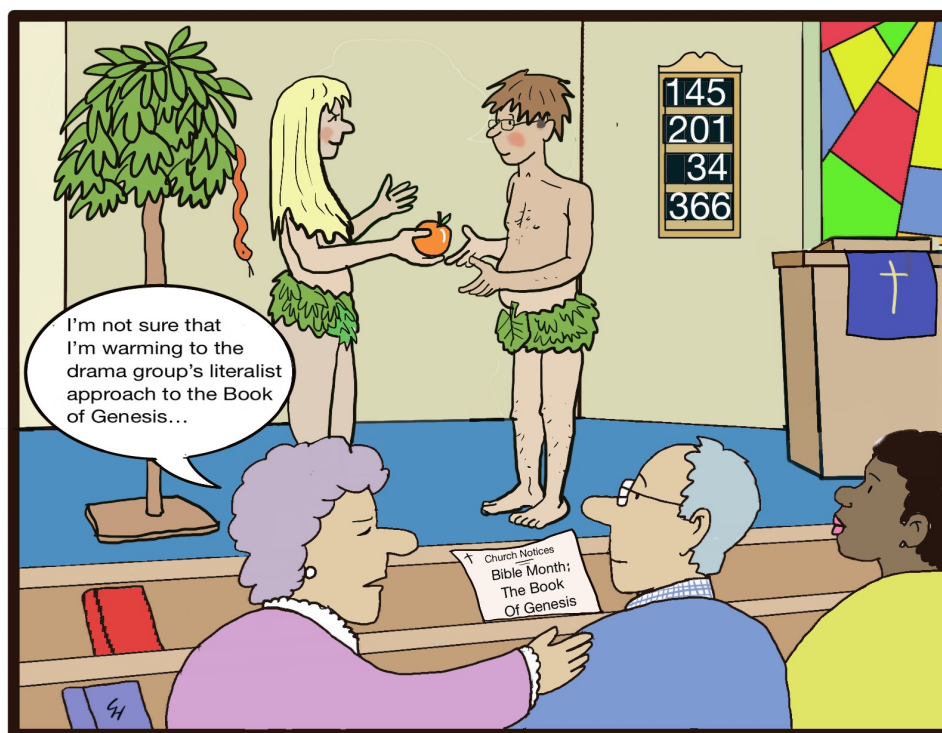
When? Thursday 12th September 2024, 10.00am for 10.30am-3.30pm
